SETSU NISEKO OFFICIALLY OPENS ITS DOORS

A Grand Christmas Tree Light Up Ceremony kicks off the celebrations in the presence of the Ambassador of the Republic of Singapore Peter Tan and the Mayor of Kutchan Kazushi Monji

(NISEKO, 9 DECEMBER 2022): Leading luxury developer SC Global Developments celebrated the official opening of its maiden hotel *Setsu Niseko* last night, the largest hotel condominium residences built in Niseko to date and one of the most significant single investments by a Singaporean company in the Hokkaido region. Guided by the concept 'Setsu Getsu Ka', the hotel's architecture and design capture the understated beauty of Japanese design with floor to ceiling windows let in the beauty of the incredible mountain landscapes. An extensive collection of art exhibited throughout the hotel and guest rooms embrace the culture and beauty of the region. The collection includes works by Kohei Nawa, master artisans of Ainu art and culture Toru Kaizawa and Mamoro Kaizawa, and local Hokkaido artists Yoko Arano and Natsuki Kobo.

In his opening address, Mr Simon Cheong, Founder and Chairman of SC Global Developments, said: "I have been visiting Niseko since 2008, the creation of Setsu Niseko is a very personal and passionate project for me.
