Keiko Lee ケイコ・リー

Since her debut album, "Imagine" in 1995, Lee has launched a remarkable career including 26 albums. A powerhouse vocalist praised by fellow musicians for her strong vocals on equal footing to musical instruments, Lee's improvisational flair and electrifying performances have captivated fans worldwide. The 2001 Nissan Stage commercial featuring her rendition of "We Will Rock You" propelled her into the mainstream, with her subsequent album "Voices" becoming a major hit, selling over 250,000 copies. Lee's accolades include topping the female vocalist category in the "Japan Jazzmen Reader Popularity Poll" for an impressive 13 consecutive years. Her popularity extends beyond Japan, with a dedicated following in Hong Kong, Taiwan, and South Korea. Lee continues to push boundaries, as evidenced by her 2015 album "LOVE XX," featuring a virtual duet with the legendary Billie Holiday. More recently, Lee released her 25th-anniversary album "Keiko Lee Live at Jazz in Lovely" (2020) and her fourth best-of collection "Voices IV" (2022).

Satoru Shionoya 塩谷 哲

Headline act Satoru Shionoya's musical journey is as diverse as it is impressive, flourishing as a pianist, composer, arranger, and producer. Shionoya has served as the pianist for award-winning ORQUESTA de la LUZ for over a decade; a group that garnered a UN Peace Prize and a Grammy nomination during his tenure. He has also released 12 solo albums, showcasing his virtuosity and compositional prowess. Shionoya's collaborative spirit extends beyond his solo work, performing alongside renowned artists like Makoto Ozone and Chikuzen Satō ("SALT & SUGAR"), as well as international jazz legends Richard Stoltzman and Steve Gadd. Shionoya's influence transcends the realm of jazz. He has contributed to the sound of popular music icon Ayaka and brought his musical vision to television, composing and arranging music for shows like "Hobby Do Raku" and "Kole Nande Shokai." Currently, Shionoya shares his vast knowledge and experience as an Associate Professor of Jazz at the National University of Music.

Junko Yagami 八神純子

Legendary Singer-Songwriter Junko Yagami rose to prominence with a bang in 1978 when her debut single "Omoide wa Utsukisugite" (Memories Are Too Beautiful) became a hit, showcasing her powerful vocals and a sound that blended disco, pop, and jazz. Never afraid to experiment incorporating elements of soul and funk to her later work. Throughout the 80's Yagami released a string of successful albums with well-known hits such as "Mizuiro no Ame" (Light Blue Rain), "Polar Star", and "Purple Town". After a temporary hiatus from her music career, Yagami returned in 2011, releasing a string of successful new albums to critical acclaim with her captivating blend of genres with her powerful vocals. Yagami has released 25 albums including live recordings, a prolific and prominent career that led her to be inducted into the Women Songwriters Hall of Fame in the USA in 2022.
